Mr. Smeltz was appointed King’s Counsel in 1980.</p> <p>James McLaren Halley, KC, who passed away on May 18, 2025 at the age of 89. Mr. Halley received his call to the Bar on June 6, 1966. He was a practising member of the Law Society for four years before relocating to British Columbia in 1970, where he continued to practise until 2011.
