1 THE CHAIR: We are in a position to provide you
2 with our decision now, which I will read out. There may be
3 a little bit of editing required, assuming I can read my
4 own handwriting, but the substance will obviously remain
5 the same. Our decision is short and to the point.

6 This matter comes before the panel on a joint
7 recommendation. Ms. Junling Wang accepts the findings of
8 professional misconduct with respect to two separate and
9 distinct failures to respond to a 14-day letter from The
10 Law Society, contrary to Rules 5-64(3) and 5-64(4), as well
11 as the facts as set forth in the citation.

12 The joint recommendation calls for a reprimand
13 with respect to Count 1, and a \$750 fine, plus \$1,500 costs
14 with respect to Count 2. The member has had no previous
15 involvement with the Discipline Committee.

16 Having reviewed the background material and
17 counsels' submissions, we see no "clear and cogent reasons"
18 for departing from the recommendation (see *R. v. Thomas*,
19 2000 MBCA 148 at para. 5 and *Rault v. Law Society of*
20 *Saskatchewan*, 2009 SKCA 81 at para. 28). We therefore
21 find, as required by Rule 5-96(5), that the acts stated in
22 the citation have been proven to our satisfaction, and
23 amount to professional misconduct.




