1 THE CHAIR: We are in a position to provide you
2 with our decision now, and our reasons can be succinctly
3 stated.

4 We are in agreement with the joint
5 recommendation of experienced counsel, being a reprimand,
6 plus a contribution of \$3,000 towards The Law Society's
7 costs. Details for payment are to be worked out with the
8 chief executive officer. This disposition is reasonable
9 and consistent with other decisions of The Law Society
10 Discipline Committee in similar circumstances.

11 Furthermore, it fully complies with the summary
12 of legal principles applicable to sentencing by Law Society
13 tribunals as set forth in Nadeau, pages 4 and 7, in that it
14 meets the two important objectives of the discipline
15 process, namely, protection of the public, and protection
16 of the reputation of the profession.

18 assistance this afternoon. I believe we stand adjourned.






