This application form is to be used by a corporation applying for:

- 1 a permit under Rule 4-3;
- 2 a new permit after an earlier permit:
 - (a) was not renewed by the corporation;
 - (b) was surrendered by the corporation to the Chief Executive Officer;
 - (c) was revoked under Law Society Rule 4-16(1);
 - (d) ceased to be valid for any other reason.

A separate application must be used for a permit for each intended law corporation.

10. **Activities of the corporation:** The corporation must not carry on any business or activity other than the practice of law and the provision of services directly associated with that practice. However, this restriction does not prohibit the law corporation from investing its own funds in real property, other than for development purposes, or in stocks, mutual funds, debit obligations, insurance, term deposits or similar investments pursuant to s. 33(3) of *The Legal Profession Act*.

11. **Accuracy of application:** I have personal knowledge of the declarations contained on this application form and of the information I have added in completing the form, and I declare that the declarations and information are true, accurate and complete.

Note: Law Society Rule 4-4 requires the corporation to inform the Chief Executive Officer of any changes in the particulars set out in this permit application form within 15 days of the change.
