PLEASE NOTE:

In the event you **do not** wish to apply to commence active practice, that pursuant to Law Society Rule 5-28.2:

“A member who is non-practising, inactive or who has completed a period of suspension, must apply to resume active practice in Manitoba and the chief executive officer may issue a practicing certificate to a member, with or without conditions or restrictions, ...”

In the event that you wish to commence active practice **within 90 days of being called to the Bar** you may, in lieu of submitting an Application to Resume, be permitted to submit an Application to Commence Active Practice, completing Part C thereof, along with the required non-refundable resumption application fee of \$52.50 (\$50.00 plus \$2.50 GST). You should submit your application, two to three weeks prior to your anticipated start date.
