THE CHAIR: Thank you for that brief recess.

The panel has made a decision.

This is an application for a pardon pursuant to section 5-101.1(1) of the Law Society Rules. The member has met all the threshold requirements for a pardon, and the only question for the panel is whether a pardon is appropriate, in other words, whether the member's 1996 conviction for conduct unbecoming a lawyer no longer reflects adversely on his character.

As put succinctly by another panel, do the offence and the offender still need to be sanctioned by way of a discipline record?

The discretionary items to be considered are the member's prior record, circumstances of the offence, complaint history, and the length of time between the offence and the application.

We heard from the Society and considered the joint recommendation and notably heard from the member this morning. The conviction back in 1996 was not law-related, and the member has had an illustrious and otherwise blemish-free career since the incident. He has been a productive and healthy member of our society.

The member's remorse is palpable even after all these years. The panel has no hesitation granting the pardon, and the anonymity back to Member A, in that while
